### Concentrations Available to Begin New Cohorts in 2019



Participants in the **Chaplaincy** cohort will have their first intensives in January, but will be spared a winter experience in Michigan—the chosen site is Altamonte Springs, Florida for the first year. A health care emphasis is available, and prior CPE is required **ONLY** for this option. Application deadline is **November 21**.



The application deadline to have a place in the new **Urban Ministry** cohort is **January 31, 2019**. This highly experiential, contextualized curriculum will include intensives in the heart of major urban locations: Chicago (USA), Toronto (Canada), and London (UK).

**Special note:** Persons who enroll in the cohort before September will receive the option of replacing some reading assignments with attendance at the September 6-8, 2018, Urban Mission and Ministry Congress (UMMC). The congress is prepared by a steering committee representing the North American Division, the General Conference, the Seminary, and others from various ministry contexts in the North American Division. **And your registration fee for the congress will be waived!** See the announcement further down in this newsletter for congress details.



**Intergenerational Church** is a brand-new concentration which will be conducted for the first time in the fall semester of 2019. Projects done within this concentration could be chosen from a wide range of approaches, encompassing family ministry, outreach and church growth, discipleship, worship, and more. Developed under the leadership of Dr. Steve Case, the application deadline is **July 31, 2019**.

All cohorts are limited to 25 participants. Applications are considered on a first-come, first-served basis, so it's to your advantage to apply early!
