1. 8:15 depart from hotel lobby - down Michigan to Wrigley Building, the three cars can park by **Wrigley, building**, then we can talk about Ft Dearborn, the river, DuSable, founding of the city.
2. 8:45 depart - right on Wabash by the river, up to Dearborn right on Dearborn to **Washington Square**, 901 N Clark St. – Sandburg, Bughouse Square.
3. 9:15 depart - to Division left on Division to **Cabrini Green and Seward Park**, legacy of Segregation/ Chicago School of Sociology

6. 11:10 depart for BJs Market on 79<sup>th</sup> for lunch, park at St Sabina's 1210 W 78<sup>th</sup> Place, a very short walk to BJ's
7. 12:30 depart from BJ's for St. Sabina's
8. 1:40 depart for Cook County Jail to 26th and California, 2700 S California Ave. 773-674-2859.
9. 3:30 depart , on the way back, left - West on 26th through **Little Village**, and right on Pulaski, then Right on 18th through Pilsen neighborhood (Hispanic). Observation
10. Left on Blue Island, stop at **Blue Island and 16th St. for some Pilsen Murals**, to Roosevelt, Right (East) on Roosevelt, left (North) on Halsted stop ever so briefly in front of **Hull House**
