CUBA STUDY TOUR FACT SHEET

1. Tour Date: March 17-27, 2017 (Spring Break)

2. Where: Holguin, Cuba

3. What: An exciting and unprecedented opportunity to share the gospel in communist Cuba. Walk in picturesque communities alongside local Bible workers and Pastors and receive practical evangelistic tools that are setting the tone to explosive church-growth in Cuba and Latin-America.

4. Academic Credit: Earn 3 academic credits while you share, learn and allow this tour to re-shape your ministry and revolutionize your soul-winning experience.

Courses to be offered (Choose 1)

CHMN 562 Field Evangelism (also called Field School), 3 cr - Ed Schmidt

CHMN 631 Field Evangelistic Preaching & Practicum, 3 cr - Fernando Ortiz

5. Cost per person: 1,850 (Early Bird). Price includes international round-trip airfare; visa, travel insurance, t-shirt, all expenses in Cuba such as: Inland transportation, food, lodging, evangelistic materials, bible workers, scenic historic tour and day trip to the beach. Expenses in the USA like: passport, airport taxes, airport meals, luggage fees, etc, are the responsibility of each participant.

6. Scholarship/Discount: \$750 to all MDiv students.

7. First step: Submit an application with a \$150 non-refundable deposit to reserve your space (deposit will be applied towards the total cost). Please note that your deposit will not qualify you for early bird or any other payment slot unless you pay in full. Checks payable to Andrews University (Subject: Cuba Tour) and deposit to AU Cashiers. To qualify for the early bird rate, turn in full amount by July 31st, 2016. Please take note that this deposit is **non-refundable** and space is limited to 24.

8. Detail of arrangements in Cuba: Dr. Fernando Ortiz, along with other Andrews University faculty members and local Cuban conference administration and district Pastors, will be responsible and personally involved in the project, making sure you are safe, comfortable and achieving success in our mission.

9. Visa: A visa is needed to enter Cuba. The cost is \$100 and it's included in the fee.

10. Passport requirements: A valid passport with at least 6 months validity by the time of departure is required.
