

(For currently employed) Are you employed by a Seventh-day Adventist organization?




Note: Graduates from international locations (mean=4.37, SD=.73) were significantly (p=0.014) more likely to recommend Andrews than those that studied on the main campus (mean=4.02, SD=1.04). Graduates with specialist or doctoral degrees (mean=4.47, SD=.66) were significantly more likely to recommend Andrews than those with either master's (mean=4.04, SD=1.00, p=0.007) or bachelor's (mean=4.09, SD=1.00, p=0.017).


