Employment & Enrollment at Graduation

The First Destination Survey asks graduates about their job placement and plans for enrollment in graduate school at the time of graduation. Numbers in this report will naturally be lower than those reported on the Alumni Survey, since the Alumni Survey asks students to report their employment and enrollment status at one year after graduation.

From the 2020 Alumni Survey,

- 67.1% of those employed were in jobs "very related" and 21.0% were in jobs "somewhat related" to their Andrews degree
- 55.6% of those enrolled in further studies were enrolled in programs "very related" and 33.3% were in programs "somewhat related" to their Andrews degree

The following is a detailed analysis of the continued education of Andrews' bachelor's graduates. Since graduating from Andrews

- 24 (36.9%) of the 65 bachelor's graduates have earned 26 additional degrees:
