




Undergraduate Retention Rates






Undergrad 4 & 6 Year Graduation Rates






Undergraduate 6 Year Graduation Rates






6-yr Graduation Rates by Ethnicity & Cohort Year






6 yr Graduation & Transfer Rates by Ethnicity, 2015 Cohort






Research Score per Full-time Faculty









(Senior involvement is at least annually)




Service Activities, Senior Survey












Salaries as Percent of Market Median






% US Alumni Donating Annually






Annual Alumni Giving






Admission to Enrollment Yield






Fall FTIAC Enrollment






Fall Census Day Headcounts, US & Distance






Fall Census Day Credits, US & Distance






Graduate vs Undergraduate (US & Distance) 12-Month Unduplicated Headcounts







12-Month Headcounts, FTE's & Credits (US & Distance)






12-mo Unduplicated Headcounts, All Campuses






12-mo Total Credits, All Campuses







