


Undergraduate Retention Rates


Undergrad 4 & 6 Year Graduation Rates



4 yr goal = 45%; 6 yr goal = 65%




6-yr Graduation Rates by Ethnicity & Cohort Year







Graduation & Transfer Rates by Ethnicity, 2012 Cohort





Senior Scores on General Skills, ETS Proficiency Profile






Research Score per Full-time Faculty




Senior Survey: Average Scores on Faith Questions



Responses indicate commitment to an active life of faith














Salaries as Percent of Market Median




% US Alumni Donating Annually






Annual Alumni Giving






Admission to Enrollment Yield




Fall FTIAC Enrollment






Fall Census Day Headcounts, US & Distance






Fall Census Day Credits, US & Distance







12-mo Unduplicated Headcounts, All Campuses






12-mo Total Credits, All Campuses






