Before you schedule your next appointment, search for the medical service you need in Cost Estimator. Here's how:

- · Scan the QR code with your phone's camera to log in or sign up for a Priority Health member account to access Cost Estimator.
- · Once logged in, click "Check a Procedure" under "Coverage check" and you will be directed to the tool through our trusted partner Healthcare Bluebook.
- · Enter a procedure name and search for locations where that service is available. From the location pricing list, select a facility to see your personal out-of-pocket estimate.
- · You can also compare costs at facilities in your network and in some cases, narrow your search by selecting a specific provider.

# What is Cost Estimator powered by Healthcare Bluebook? And other frequently asked questions

## **COST ESTIMATES**

#### What is Cost Estimator, powered by Healthcare Bluebook?

Priority Health has partnered with Healthcare Bluebook as a vendor for its price transparency tools. Healthcare Bluebook is a healthcare company that helps users find quality healthcare providers, providing price transparency and offering savings through comparison shopping.

Cost Estimator is a free tool that factors in the provider and location, as well as your plan's deductible, out-of-pocket maximum and any applicable copay and/or coinsurance to give you an estimate of your personalized member cost share.

#### What is the "Fair price?"

The Fair Price™ is the amount you should reasonably expect to pay for a service or procedure and is based on the actual amount paid on the claim, not the billed amount. Eligible members can earn rewards on select procedures by using Fair Price™ (green) facilities.

#### How do I find a "Fair Price?"

Color-coded cost symbols denote cost rankings for facilities to help you easily identify where a facility falls in comparison to the Fair Price. Providers are listed in order of lowest price to highest price.

**Green circle** = at or below the Fair Price **Yellow square** = slightly above the Fair Price

Red octagon/stop sign = significantly above the Fair Price.

#### Is my health information kept private?

Healthcare Bluebook does not share information about individual members. All healthcare information is kept confidential.

## **How does PriorityRewards work?**

When you use the Cost Estimator, you can be rewarded for being a smart shopper. Many common procedures are included in the **Priority**Rewards program. If you receive the medical service from a provider below the Fair Price within 13 months of the search, you'll be rewarded with a reloadable Visa debit card.

### How will I receive my reward? How long does it take?

Rewards will be processed monthly but may be delayed due to the time it takes for claims to be billed and processed. Your reward and a letter of explanation will be sent to the address you have on file.

#### Are my family members eligible to receive rewards?

Family members who are participating in the health plan can earn rewards. However, rewards are always paid to the plan subscriber.

#### Can I earn multiple rewards?

Yes, you may receive multiple rewards for procedures rendered - even on the same day. For example, if you had cataract surgery on both eyes, you would receive two separate rewards for using a Fair Price™ (green) provider.
