Reciprocal Teaching

Students are grouped by pairs. Both students read the same material. Then one student acts as the teacher and does the following:

- 1. Clarifies hard parts
- 2. Asks several high level questions
- 3. Summarizes the paragraph
- 4. Predicts what will be in the next segment

Both read the next segment. Then the other student acts as the teacher and follows the above four steps.

Proceed through the reading as indicated.
