The minutes from the April 9/97 meeting were discussed and approved.

The council reviewed action #1 taken on Oct 16-1996 regarding credits from Home Study International and the concept of "full reciprocity". The policy as stated only includes HSI courses and not those from CUC and Grigg's University which still exist. It was **voted** that action #1 (Oct 16, 1996) which removed the 24 cr. limit on the number of correspondence courses that can be taken, includes all correspondence courses not just those from HSI.

The residency requirement needs to be evaluated as the climate for distance learning has changed. It was **voted** that Arthur Coetzee, Suzan Zork, and Dave Penner from an ad hoc committee are to review this matter and bring a report for the Council for review.

Academic Policies and Subcommittee brought a report regarding double majors which is to be voted on next meeting. Some clarification of the wording was suggested so that it is clear that the requirements for both majors must be met.

It was voted to commission the chair of this committee to speak directly to the new VP of Academic Administration about our concern regarding the need for scheduling program reviews.
